Country Club Boulevard Reconstruction Project Start-up


The City of Sioux City Engineering Division announces the start of the Country Club Boulevard Reconstruction Project from 38th Street to West Kings Highway on May 31, 2016. This project includes new water, sanitary and storm sewer utility infrastructure and street, driveway, and sidewalk paving reconstruction. This project will be completed in seven stages, two stages in 2016 and five stages in 2017. All work within Stage I and Stage II is to be completed on or before November 15, 2016. Stage I


Stage I reconstruction will require the full closure of Country Club Boulevard north of 38th Street to south of 40th Street. A detour route along 38th Street, Orchard Street and 40th Street will be posted. This stage is anticipated to be completed in early August.

Stage II

Once Stage I is complete Stage II will begin and include the reconstruction of Country Club Boulevard south of 40th Street to south of Harvest Road. A detour route along 38th Street, Orchard Street, 40th Street, Perry Way, and 43rd Street will be posted. The closure of the 40th Street intersection is limited to 35 calendar days during which time a temporary access road will be installed to allow for continued access along 40th Street.
