ReEvent – the next electronics take back event is scheduled for October 15th. Melissa is verifying all vendors for the event and scheduling the skywalk banner.

*Once we get responses from private companies regarding glass recycling containers, we can schedule a Study Session with Council on the direction of future endeavors and update them on current issues.

*Melissa and Carrie will have a booth at the Sun N Fun Senior Citizen Event in Merville August 16th.

*Look into the possibility of Gill Hauling putting a giant magnetic billboard on the side of their Recycling Trucks so that citizens can distinguish between garbage and recycling when they are being collected.

*With Gill Hauling's' help what is the possibility of a giant sticky note being put on garbage totes announcing they can get a free recycle bin?
