CRITERIA FOR A PHASE 2 SOURCE WATER PROTECTION (SWP) PLAN

1) A SWP Community Planning Team

- a) Required participants (If you cannot get representatives from these groups to participate, please call the IDNR SWP Program at 515-281-0932 to discuss other options.)
 - i) A minimum of 1 city or governing entity representative in addition to the city water operator.
 - ii) A USDA-NRCS and/or County SWCD representative
 - iii) At least one land owner and/or operator from the 2, 5, or 10 year capture zone areas.
- b) In addition, an IDNR field office representative should attend at least one SWP planning team meeting.
- c) In addition, suggested participants include: the county sanitarian, the community historian, and other local, state, and federal elected officials.
- d) Planning Team members contact information shall be included in the plan.
