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CHAPTER 2.28. TRANSIT SYSTEM ADVISORY BOARD

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2.28.010 Board Created.

There is created a five-member board (board), for the purpose of advising the city council on the operation of the municipal transit system in Sioux City and surrounding communities consistent with the terms and provisions of this chapter, to be known as the Sioux City transit system advisory board.

2.28.020 Appointment and Qualifications.

The members of the board shall be appointed by a majority vote of the city council. To be eligible to be appointed a member of the board, the appointee must be a qualified resident elector of Sioux City. Before assuming the duties of office, each member shall file with the city clerk an oath for the faithful performance of the member's duties, and a disclosure of his ownership or control or prior ownership and control within the preceding two years of any interest, direct or indirect, in any property included or planned to be included in an urban renewal project.

2.28.040 Organization of the Board.

As soon as possible after the appointment of the initial members, the board shall organize for the transaction of business, elect a chairperson from its own membership, appoint a secretary, and adopt bylaws and regulations to govern the proceedings of the board. Three members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. All actions of the board shall be by either resolution or motion and the affirmative vote of at least three members shall be necessary for the passage of either action.

2.28.050 Meetings and Minutes.

The board shall hold at least one public meeting each month. Minutes of each meeting shall be kept and all resolutions and minutes shall be open to public inspection.

2.28.060 Duties of the Board.

Except as otherwise provided hereinafter, the board shall make recommendations to the city council on the operation of the Sioux City transit system including, but not limited to the following areas:

1. Rules and regulations for the control, operation, supervision and maintenance of the system;
2. The purchase, lease, sale, or exchange of any property for the benefit and efficient operation of the system and the terms and conditions of the transaction;
3. The necessary personnel to operate the system and their compensation;
4. The rates and fares for the transportation of passengers and incidental services;
5. Advertising on buses and other facilities;
6. The advisability of applying for grants or subsidies from any other unit of government;
7. The procurement of insurance as is felt necessary for the protection of the system;
8. Advertisement of services offered by the Sioux City transit system;
9. The advisability of accepting or rejecting gifts of property or money to the transit system.

2.28.070 Responsibilities of the Board.

It shall be the responsibility of the board of transit trustees to:

1. File with the city clerk for public inspection copies of minutes of all board meetings and resolutions duly passed by the board within fourteen days of the meetings at which such action was taken;
2. Submit to the city council its recommendations on the annual budget for the expenditure of transit revenues and municipal funds allotted for the transit system.

2.28.080 Removal of Trustees.

Trustees may be removed by a majority vote of the city council for good cause shown as determined by the council.
