

Floyd Valley Interior Ponding Meeting City Hall and Leeds School Meetings February 20, 2013


February 2013 - **FEMA** is expect to publish notice of map revision

This will begin an 18 month process of review and public comment periods.

This is the first of many meetings to introduce the map changes.

Future meetings will identify improvements to the levee system to reduce these interior ponding areas in the future.

Levee Certification was completed by HR Green and approved by FEMA on **July 3, 2012**.

Provisional Accreditation may be removed from the FIRM.

In so doing, Interior Ponding, as identified under 44CFR 65.10 (b) (6), shall be incorporated into the FIRM (Flood Insurance Rate Map) as a special flood hazard area.


Effectively, the levee protection area is now an interior ponding area.

Mitigation Measures


Since 2011, the City has added drainage inlets along Stueben Street.

The City will work with the USACE to identify projects to reduce the potential of interior ponding.


Levee Protected Area vs Interior Ponding



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
