

What portion of my sewer service am I responsible for?

Each resident is responsible for their own sewer service from their house all the way to the point where the sewer service connects to main line sanitary sewer. This includes the "sewer wye" which is a "T-shaped" piece of sanitary sewer where your private sewer service funnels into.

The sanitary sewer is typically located in the center of the road way. New construction projects often place sanitary sewer service "stubs" to a distance just past the street curb, so that newly constructed homes do not have to remove costly street paving to connect to the main line sanitary sewer.
