Motion Approved Unanimously.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Air Service: They have several new employees who are doing fairly well considering the winter weather conditions.

Construction Projects Update: Terminal Ramp Rehab Project painting in the spring. The NE Taxilane is substantially complete and will also finish up in the spring. T-Hangar footings are in and building materials are onsite. Weekly meetings for the SUX Aviation Center, preparing for final inspection potentially next week with the fire marshal. Assuming occupancy to Oracle on February 1st. Planning for a full open house in May as they will be working on the build out of the second floor.

SkyWest Airlines: Staff is unavailable.

Hawthorne: Bryan Orr reported that he's getting settled in.

Oracle: Staff is unavailable.

ABM: Issues with gates. Parkonect sent staff from Chicago over and traced it back to some

firmware updates. Everything appears to be back on track.

Air Museum: Staff is unavailable.

185th **ARW:** Another meeting with the Guard Bureau, RS&H and the City.

<u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>- Financials are in the positive. Car rental concessions and airport parking all help. Expenses are remaining flat in general. After confirmation from the FAA, we are able to distribute a check to the concessionaires who qualified for aid in connection to the pandemic.

We had a TAC Meeting in connection to the Master Plan Update. We anticipate a May public meeting. Perley was in attendance and appreciated in learning where the projections come from to determine future traffic. General aviation discussions around flight schools. Projections show 2%-6% growth in the next five to ten years.

<u>MARKETING</u>- December was a good month and was up 71% and 56% YTD. Operations continue to be up 53%. Enplanements are up 42% and we ended up 5% for the year. Load factors remained strong with 80% DEN and 76% ORD. The Board did preference SkyWest and they were officially awarded the contract with the DOT in December.

BOARD CONCERNS- None.
