

With the continued work on all three segments of the I-29 Reconstruction in the Sioux City Area, motorists should be alert that the posted speed limit is now 55 miles per hour on the interstate.

Previous phasing allowed some sections to remain at higher speed limits, but with additional projects starting and overlapping work zones, the speed limit for the entire stretch of interstate from the start of construction near Sergeant Bluff to the South Dakota border is now 55 mph in both directions.

Failure to adhere to this limit in the work zones significantly increases the hazard for all motorists and can result in substantial fines. Please be respectful of the construction workers in the area as they work to improve access to Sioux City and our quality of life.
