The Sioux City Public Museum will have special hours for the 2016 Holiday Lighted Parade and after the Thanksgiving holiday, announced Steve Hansen, Museum director today.

The Sioux City Public Museum will be open from 5 to 8 p.m. on Monday, November 21. Starting at 6:15 p.m. on 4th and Iowa Streets, the Holiday Lighted Parade will proceed west along 4th Street to the corner of 4th and Nebraska Streets in front of the Sioux City Public Museum where Santa will light up the holiday tree on the Museum Plaza. Hansen also announced the holiday hours for the Sioux City Public Museum and Sergeant Floyd River Museum and Welcome Center. Both locations will be closed on Thursday, November 24 in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday. The Sergeant Floyd River Museum & Welcome Center will resume their regular opening hours the day after Thanksgiving on Friday, November 25. The Sioux City Public Museum will remain closed on November 25, which is a City holiday. The Museum will re-open on Saturday, November 26.

The Sioux City Public Museum, 607 4th Street, is regularly open Tuesday through Saturday 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday 1 to 5 p.m. The Sergeant Floyd River Museum and Welcome Center, 1000 Larsen Park Road, is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. As an official Iowa welcome center, the Sergeant Floyd only closes for major holidays.
