

Officials at Sioux Gateway Airport/Col. Bud Day Field in Sioux City reported today that year-to-date traffic is up 35% over 2015, aided by the addition of the new daily flight to Dallas/Ft. Worth. Daily air service operated by American Airlines from Sioux City to Dallas/Ft. Worth began on May 5, 2016. Since that day, flights have been very busy, with load factors averaging over 80% on most flights.

“We’re excited to see our market respond to this new service so quickly. Travelers are using the convenient daily flight to Dallas/Ft. Worth to connect to the West and Southeast as well as to visit the Dallas/Ft. Worth Metro area,” said Darrell Jesse, Sioux Gateway Airport Board President. “The flight has been a welcome addition to the two daily flights on American Airlines to Chicago.”

With the holidays just around the corner, travelers are encouraged to book their flights early.

Activity at Sioux Gateway Airport also continues with the addition of a newly constructed 10-unit

T-Hangar project to house private aircraft and a \$26 million rehabilitation of the crosswind runway planned to begin next year and to be phased over multiple years.
